- North Side Journal will be covering Dairy Days in their May edition that is being mailed to Wendell mail boxes.
- Paula had prepared a flier with the dates for a press release and publicity use.
- Parade Rick Cowen and Annie Burke will be handling. Parade entries will need to be given to Annie. It was mentioned that the parade registration book will need to be delivered to the announcer well in advance of the start of the parade. AS Well as picking up after the parade. Awards/certificates will be decided by Rick/Annie.
- Scholarship collected total \$18,5400. With some more to possibly come in. Sharon gave Paula the ad copies as well as a thumb drive for the book.
- Dunk tank for Dairymen with begin approx. noon. Rita is to pick up the dunk tank Friday and return Sunday. (Sharon offered to pay for the tank.)

- Garbage – The tractor trailer will be provided again by Paul (Wendell Cemetery) The WHS Honor Society, Advisor Geianne Choate will pick up the trash as a service project Friday and Saturday. (A back-up for this may be the softball team from Gooding – Contact Susie Pavkov they would use as a money maker.)
- Show & Shine car show Louie mentioned all is on track, lost a few sponsors from last year and picked up a few new. He will be serving breakfast again at the car show.
- Marking out the spaces will be Louie, Leo & Paul this year. Leo to order more paint for this purpose. They will be making a better walkway to the car show.

- Scholarship committee is Jon, Carol, Leo & Gary. The application process is closed. Becky Shubert will contact Jerome Schools, no participants again this year. (Side note; Giltner will donate \$1,000 if a Jerome student could be awarded a scholarship)
